Dear Supplier:

Effective immediately, the forms used to collect inventory information for the NLOS-C Advanced Procurement/Special Interest subcontract have been replaced. New forms have been issued that supersede the SF1429 form which is used to provide back-up detailed information to Form SF1428 Inventory Disposition Schedule.

The revised form, supporting information, and a list of instructions on how to complete the form have been posted to the General Dynamics Land Systems (GDLS) Supply Chain Management web site at <http://procurement.gdls.com/FCS/FCSTermination.html> under NLOS-C/Special Interest Material Instructions.

Each supplier must submit its NLOS-C/Special Interest inventory using the revised form. The government database (PCARSS) will not allow GDLS to enter any inventory information that is not provided on the form and in the format requested. This is a US Government requirement and cannot be revised.

Please be advised that GDLS will not accept any Termination Settlement Proposals that do not comply with the revised inventory reporting requirements.

As a result of this GDLS mandated change in the forms used to report inventory GDLS will extend the date each supplier's TSP is due to GDLS from 16 January 2010 to 02 February 2010.

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You are directed to acknowledge this change in reporting NLOS-C /Special Interest inventory and your company's compliance by signing and returning a copy **by CLOSE OF BUSINESS THURSDAY, 08 January 2010** via e-mail to scmbusin@gdls.com. **In your acknowledgement, advise the undersigned whether the termination can be settled at no cost to the Buyer or whether you anticipate filing a settlement proposal.**

Other than that explicitly stated herein, no change in any other GDLS subcontract / purchase order, prices, terms or conditions is intended or authorized by this correspondence.
